To do so, the Hispanic Federation has taken unprecedented action, helping to coordinate hundreds of donation drives in the U.S. mainland and distributing millions of pounds of food, water and essentials to those most affected by the storm. So much of this work has been made possible because people from across our nation and the world have stood shoulder to shoulder with us. In fact, we have received contributions from more than 200,000 people from all 50 states, every US territory, and from 63 countries around the globe.
